A new 16,000-square-foot-facility building nears completion in Monroe Township, Clarion County, in the well-traveled Interstate-80 exchange near Clarion's primary shopping plazas on Route 68.

The Penn Highlands Healthcare Clarion Community Medical Building will increase access to Penn Highlands' services and care for those living in the Clarion region. The new facility will provide access to quality primary and walk-in care through the addition of the QCare Clarion walk-in clinic. The new Penn Highlands Community Pharmacy will meet our patient's prescription needs. New outpatient services will also include outpatient physical therapy, and walk-in imaging (x-ray), 3D mammography and other women's imaging services and laboratory services.

The facility will expand access to more specialty services being offered to the region including endocrinology, gastroenterology, pulmonology and coming soon family medicine, medical oncology, orthopedics and sports medicine. Moving from their current Clarion office location to the new facility will be Penn Highlands Life's Journey (obstetrics/gynecology).
